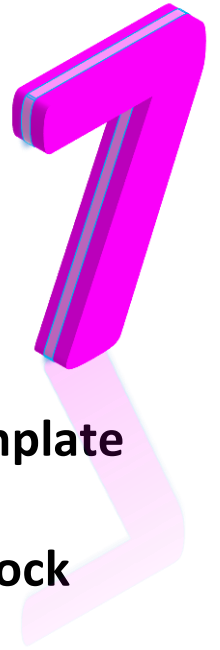


# Block Letter CHECKLIST

- Double check the spelling of your word
- Draw a speech bubble and add some Ben Day dots or other appropriate shapes
- Fill in the letters with black
- Leaving the speech bubble white, paint the background using only magenta, yellow or cyan.
- Clean your brushes with soap and place them to dry in the brush holder bristles up.
