

Grid Self-Portrait Enlargement

Focus: Use a grid to create an enlargement of a self- portrait.

Color will be added with Colored pencil, marker or crayon.

Steps and Requirements:

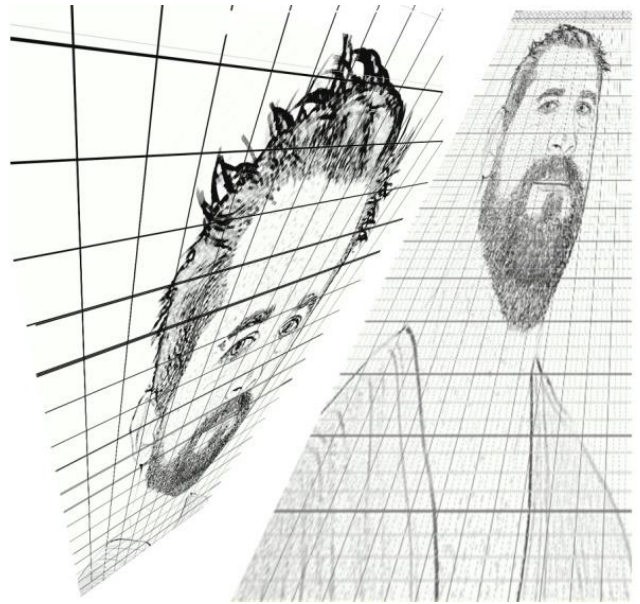
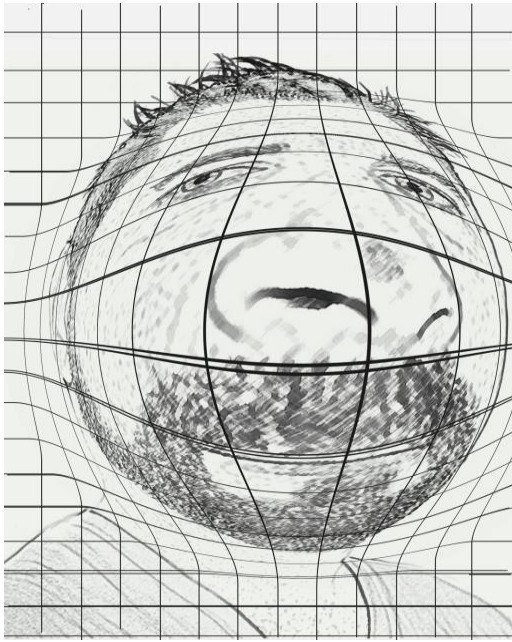
1. Print an 8x10 photograph of your face
2. Draw a square grid on the photo (1"x1" for an 8x10 portrait)
3. Choose a grid style to distort your self portrait. Choose from Sphere, Perspective, Warped and Flatten.
4. Draw this distorted grid onto a larger piece of paper. You must have the same number of cells on your large paper as you have on your original.
5. Sketch your photo image on the larger paper cell by cell
6. Add color with colored pencil, marker or crayon.

Self-Evaluation

Grade yourself 1-4 on the following requirements

- Designed a grid to be used for the final drawing
- Used a 2" grid to effectively transform an image
- Distortion of face is dramatic, interesting and creative
- Grid lines were erased completely, and color was applied neatly
- Stayed on task and worked efficiently

Sphere-
grid lines start straight but curve in
the center



Perspective-
grid lines get incrementally
closer and may be at an angle

Warped-
all grid lines are curved

Flatten- grid lines are
uniformly spaced and the
angle of one axis is changed
